### IJGA DIRECTOR OF GOLF JONATHAN YARWOOD NAMED TO GOLF MAGAZINE'S TOP 100 TEACHERS



It takes blood, sweat and tees to become a Top 100 Teacher, one of the most coveted titles in golf instruction. Per GOLF Magazine, "Each of these slice-busting, swing-fixing pros have the right stuff."

The International Junior Golf Academy (IJGA), the oldest, independent junior golf academy in the nation, is proud to announce **Director of Golf & Instruction, Jonathan Yarwood,** has been named to **GOLF Magazine's Top 100 Teachers in America,** the longest-running list of elite teachers (25 years and counting.)

Yarwood is one of 16 new members on the elite list this year. Since its inception in 1991, GOLF Magazine's Top Teachers in America ranking has become the industry standard for teaching excellence. Four different committees comprised of peer review, World Golf Teacher Hall of Fame members, established Top 100 teachers and alumni and GOLF Magazine, judge candidates on 15 baseline criteria.

Yarwood, a British PGA Master Professional, has a long-standing career that speaks for itself. He has trained a U.S. Open winner, two U.S. Amateur winners, two U.S. Girls' winners, three AJGA Players of the Year, four #1 juniors, a collegiate #1 and winners on the PGA, LPGA,

European, Challenge, Asian and Australasian tours. He has been recognized for his contribution to the game by being the youngest person to be made a British PGA Master Professional in 2011. He was also voted a "Top 20 Teacher under 40" by Golf Digest, and "Best Teachers in State Rankings" for over a decade. He has trained studentathletes of 11 years of age until they ultimately reached the tour. He is proud to be a part of the world-class team at IJGA and to bring his experience to a new generation of junior players.

"I have never really converted titles nor acknowledgement in my career, preferring to get my head down in the trenches and make a contribution that satisfied my curiosity," said Yarwood. "Having said that, it is always a nice feeling to know that your work has been noted and appreciated by a peer group whom I highly respect. I'm both humbled and honored to receive this award and will continue to strive to improve and make a difference in the lives of others through the coaching skills I've developed."

"Jonathan is perhaps the most accomplished golf coach in junior golf, with a decade coaching the elite group of players at IMG, followed by many years on the professional tour with players such as Michael Campbell, who went head to head with Tiger Woods at his peak to win the 2007 US

> Open, and now five years with our International Junior Golf Academy ("IJGA") and partner Bishops Gate Golf Academy ("BGGA")," said Andrew Summers, IJGA and BGGA CEO. "Since taking on the challenge of restoring the IJGA brand as the leading junior golf academy, Jonathan has done an immense job in building a disciplined golf program, with a mixture of artistry and use of the most modern technical aids, and it is inspiring to see the pride with which his

students perform in practice and in tournaments. Jonathan is quite rightly recognized as a Top 100 Instructor and we are fortunate at IJGA to have him lead our golf program."

#### **Faldo Series Major Champions Invitational**


IJGA student-athlete Merlin Dohm recently participated in the Faldo Series Major Champions Invitational held at Bella Collina, Monteverde, Florida.

# PLANNING, DEDICATION AND PERSEVERANCE YIELDS COLLEGE ACCEPTANCE RESULTS

During my first months as a member of the IJGA/BGGA team, it has been a privilege to meet our fabulous, student-athletes from around the globe. These young men and women have come to pursue their road to U.S. College and for that, we are honored to have been entrusted to help prepare their path.

I have been involved in the American system of education for over two decades and have visited hundreds of college campuses. There are over 3000 colleges and universities in America. For our male student-athletes -

1289 of the 3000 colleges have golf teams (Division I, Division III, Division III, NAIA or NJCAA). Our female student-athletes have 939 colleges to consider that have a golf team. So, it is important to note that roughly half of all of the U.S. colleges and universities have men's golf teams and roughly one-third have women's golf teams.

copious notes, studying for tests, proper sleep, attending study hall and hiring private tutors, when necessary.

Earning a SAT and/or ACT score that is reflective of a student's ability will take hours of preparation. Effective for the 2019-20 school year, each student will be given a set of test prep books for the TOEFL (if applicable), PSAT/ACT Plan and SAT/ACT. These books will be used throughout the year to study for the age-appropriate tests. There are also free, test-prep resources that we share with our students and are available online.

Additionally, we have created a partnership with Method Test Prep (MTP) - the gold standard in strategy-based test prep. Each student/family will be introduced to Elliot Bock, the Director of Online Education at MTP. To achieve a goal SAT/ACT score, private test prep is an excellent additional investment. A goal score can help a student gain admission to their #1 choice college/university, but it can also

help them qualify for a Merit Scholarship.

As a student prepares for college, the two most important areas of focus that will dictate the outcome, include:

- Strive for the lowest average golf score
- Strive for the highest GPA and SAT/ACT score

To achieve the lowest golf score, the student-athletes will work hand-in-hand with their golf coaching team, including: Director of Golf, their lead coach, strength and conditioning coach, mental performance coach and custom club fitter. Together, with their Junior Golf Scoreboard ranking, the students will naturally fit into a college/university team's scoring average.

To achieve the highest GPA, a student will work closely with their school's guidance counselor and their academy's educational coordinator. A's & B's come with hard work, including attending class regularly, taking

Although this is a data driven process, it is our goal to help our student-athletes find a RIGHT fit college match, meeting their social, emotional, physical, spiritual and intellectual needs...including a financial fit to meet a family's budget. Going forward, the college conversation will be frequent and the IJGA + BGGA college preparation will be robust; starting in the 9th grade.

In the fall of 2019, every student will have a designated software page in our College Planner Pro (CPP) software. We are excited to announce that each family will also have access to the CPP college page, available and translated in their native language. This will allow the parents to have insight into their child's college planning. In turn, it will allow the parents to support, encourage and occasionally nudge their children so we are all on the same page to help support these remarkable student-athletes achieve their goals.


