## Felix van Kleef - University of Nevada, Las Vegas (D1)

Felix van Kleef has committed to play on the men's college team at the University of Nevada, Las Vegas (UNLV). UNLV competes in the NCAA Division I Mountain West Conference.

Van Kleef is a former member of the German National Team. He won the 2016 Austrian Junior Golf Tour and the 2018 Greg Norman Championship Golf Academy Open. Van Kleef also made the cut at the PGA Tour's 2018 Wyndham Championship Pre-Qualifier with a score of 70 in a field of 150. He was the second-lowest of three amateurs to qualify. Additionally, he won the 2018 SCJGA 24th Annual Fall Challenge.

"I want to make my family proud of me. My role model is my dad," said van Kleef. He added, "I'll miss my friends and the great atmosphere at IJGA. Jonathan is such a great coach."

#### Kotaro Murata - University of Hawaii (D1)

Kotaro Murata of Japan, has committed to play on the men's golf team at the University of Hawaii (UH), Manoa, of Honolulu, Hawaii. UH is an NCAA Division I school and competes in the Big West Conference.



Murata's career golf highlights include wins at the Hurricane Junior Tour Elite Series at Orange Lake Resort 2018, IJGT Orange Lake Open 2018, IJGT Island Open at Dolphin Head 2017, and medalist at the IMG Junior Qualifying Tournament and the AJGA Davis Love III

Junior Open 2017. Murata is currently ranked 219 on the Rolex AJGA Rankings.

"My dad encouraged me to start playing golf at eight years old. He also played for fun. I hated it at first until I played in a tournament. Then I realized that I needed to practice harder to be competitive," said Murata. "What I really enjoy, is executing my golf plan and seeing results."



## Chase Phillips - George Mason University (D1)

Chase Phillips has committed to play on the men's golf team at George Mason University (GMU) of Fairfax, Virginia. GMU is a



Division I school who competes in the Atlantic 10 Conference.

Phillips golfing highlights include winning the IJGT Disney Classic 2017, placing second in the Thanksgiving Classic at Sawgrass 2016, finishing third at the Coastal Carolina Junior Open 2018, third-place at the HJGT Island Invitational on Hilton Head Island 2018 and placing fifth in the International Junior Golf Tournament (IJGT) Tournament of Champions 2018.

"It is a true blessing to be able to work with world-class coaches at IJGA. This is my fifth year at IJGA and I've never seen a more well-rounded, hard working and dedicated team of coaches. The changes that Jonathan Yarwood has made at IJGA are truly remarkable and I'm really excited to see what's in store for the future," said Phillips.

## Hoshi Yadav - Holy Names University (D2)

Hoshi Yadav of Dubai, United Arab Emirates, has committed to play on the men's golf team at Holy Names University (HNU) of Oakland, CA. HNU competes in the Pacific West Conference which is the largest NCAA Division II conference



in the Western region. Yadav will attend HNU in the fall of 2019 and play for Hawk's head coach Chris Oetinger.

Yadav's golf career highlights include a win at Junior Club Championship JGE in Dubai, second-place finishes at HJGT The Palmetto Classic

2018, Central Florida Classic 2018, Coastal Carolina Junior Challenge 2017 and Faldo Series Middle East 2017.

"My experience at IJGA has been great as I have been able to make friends from all over the world. IJGA has provided me with world-class facilities to really hone my game and take it to a whole new level," said Yadav.

## Drew Maiorca - Chestnut Hill College (D2)

Drew Maiorca of Lake Placid, New York, has committed to play on the men's golf team at Chestnut Hill College (CHC) of Philadelphia, PA. CHC is a Division II school and competes in the Central Atlantic Collegiate



Conference. Maiorca will play for the Griffin's head coach Mike Paukovits.

Maiorca's golf career highlights include a win at Lake Placid High School Team at the Craig Wood Golf Course 2018, and second-place finishes at New York High School Section VII at North Country Golf Club 2018 and New York High School Section VII at the Barracks Golf Course 2017.

"Drew has really applied himself at IJGA, and as a result is starting to get his rewards. His speed and ball striking have increased enormously in his time at IJGA. He is becoming a very competent golfer as a result," said IJGA Director of Golf Jonathan Yarwood.

#### Beng Keat Lim - Ottawa University (NAIA)

Beng Keat Lim of Malaysia, has committed to play on the men's golf team at the Ottawa University (OUAZ) of Surprise, Arizona. As a newer program, OUAZ is currently a member of NAIA and they compete in the Golden State Athletics Conference.



Lim's golf career highlights include first-place finishes at the SportsExcel Malaysian Junior Golf Circuit 2018 Leg 1, Sarawak Chief Minister Cup / 18th Sarawak International Junior Championship 2016 and KGM Amatuer Open Golf Championship 2016.

"Beng Keat Lim is a really strong player who is heading towards the tour in the future. He will be a great team player and offer a strong contribution to this team," said IJGA Director of Golf Jonathan Yarwood.




#### **Swing Catalyst Certification**
