Our number one goal for each semester is to make progress from start to finish and provide the absolute best environment for IJGA student-athletes to develop. In order to do this, we have grown to understand the importance in setting the tone and bringing the entire IJGA community together, focusing the combined energy for the new semester into an opportunity

which provides fun, perspective and reinforces commitments to goals and affirmations.

As we kicked off the 2019 spring semester on Martin Luther King, Jr. Day, we started with a basic challenge and asked students to take actions they would be proud of and believe that at the end of the event, those who acted with the future in mind would have the opportunity to break into that potential with

actions that reflected the gold inside. We then reflected on the workings of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. and his ability to see past the violence in his face — to the golden opportunity on the other side of taking actions which stood to provide opportunity for all. This was followed by a "Habitudes" lesson which highlighted the importance of identifying one's inner gold and how, in being a leader, knowing how to perform one's strengths helps to have more success and even influence others.

List three things your co-workers probably don't know about you ...



As a qualifying event, Lamarca will advance to the Optimist International Junior Golf Championship held at the Trump National Doral Resort & Spa Tournament held in Miami, Florida in late July.

The Canadian Junior Golf Association (CJGA) recently announced the winners of the 2018 GOLFTEC National Order of Merit, presented

by TaylorMade. The GOLFTEC National Order of Merit, presented by TaylorMade is a ranking system that awards points based on a player's position at each CJGA event. Events are tiered based on the size and strength of the field.

IJGA student-athlete Micheal Katsman (Richmond Hill, Ont.) played in six events collecting 2,563 points during the 2018 season. Posting top five finishing in both the CJGA PING Canadian Junior Match Play Championship and CJGA Mizuno National Junior Golf Championship, Katsman never finished outside the top five at an event. He captured the CJGA Humber College Invitational at Diamondback and finished runner-up at the DeLaet Cup Qualifier presented by Georgian College at National Pines.


